A celebration of the drama and intensity of the mother-child relationship, Margaret Drabble's *The Millstone* won the John Llewellyn Rhys Prize in 1965. She conceals her ignorance beneath a show of independence, and becomes pregnant as a result of a one night stand. Although single parenthood is still not socially acceptable, she chooses to have the baby rather than to seek an illegal abortion, and finds her life transformed by motherhood. Her many novels include *The Radiant Way* (1987), *A Natural Curiosity* (1989), *The Gates of Ivory* (1991), *The Peppered Moth* (2000), *The Seven Sisters* (2002) and *The Red Queen* (2004) all of which are published by Penguin. In 1980, Margaret Drabble was made a CBE and in 2008 she was made DBE. She is married to the biographer Michael Holroyd, and lives in London and Somerset.
